Values Be Kind, Work Hard

**Teamwork**: We work together to achieve our team goals and support each other in achieving individual goals.

**Respect**: We respect ourselves and others and embrace our diversity

**Accountability**: We hold ourselves and each other accountable for our words and our actions.

**Integrity**: We have a high regard for truth, play according to the rules, strive to act in ethical ways and are sincere in our

actions.

**Humility**: We are grateful for our opportunities and mindful that our participation in athletics is a privilege and not an

entitlement.

Sportsmanship: We are gracious competitors regardless of the final score and conduct ourselves with dignity in victory, under

pressure and in the face of adversity.

### **Swimmers**

1. Play fairly and follow the rules and regulations.

- 2. Be respectful of authority including coaches, team representatives, parent volunteers and league officials.
- 3. Be a good sport before, during and after practices and meets.
- Be courteous to opposing teams.
- 5. Be modest when you win and gracious when you lose.
- 6. Properly use and protect the equipment and facilities.
- 7. Refrain from cursing or other abusive language and the use of performance enhancing or mind altering drugs including alcohol and tobacco.
- 8. Abide by the dress code. (one-piece style swim suit for girls, jammers or speedo style swim trunks for boys at practice & meets)
- 9. Be responsible for your behavior.

#### Parents/Guardians or Other Volunteer

- 1. Model good sportsmanship with positive support for all swimmers, coaches, fans and officials at all times.
- 2. Place the well being of your child over competitive goals.
- 3. Model an environment that is free of performance enhancing or mind altering drugs including alcohol and tobacco.
- 4. Encourage my child to play by the rules, respect authority and the rights of other swimmers, coaches, fans and officials.
- 5. Demonstrate positive problem-solving skills by raising concerns in a calm manner with the proper authority so they can be addressed in an appropriate and timely manner.
- 6. Be responsible for your behavior and the behavior of your child(ren).

## Coaches and Team Representatives

- 1. Place the emotional and physical well being of the swimmers ahead of my competitive desires or needs.
- 2. Provide a safe swimming environment for all participants.
- 3. Lead by example in demonstrating calm authority, respect, fair play and good sportsmanship in all circumstances.
- 4. Provide a team experience that is free of cursing or other abusive language, performance enhancing or mind altering drugs including alcohol and tobacco.
- 5. Provide opportunities for each swimmer to improve, mature and fair opportunities to compete.
- 6. Be knowledgeable and follow the league rules and regulations, teach these rules to all swimmers and be able to explain the rules to parents/guardians.
- 7. Be responsible for your own behavior and the behavior of your team.
